You can participate in alleviating the effects of hunger and poverty in many ways. Read over this list prayerfully to discern what God is calling you to do.

- Start or join the *Tikkun Olam* or Social Action Committee of your congregation.
- Find out how to become involved in your movement's programs in these areas.
- Volunteer in a soup kitchen, food pantry, food bank or homeless shelter.
- Write a letter or editorial to local newspapers about these issues and public policy.
- Talk with others about these issues, helping bring the awareness of the concerns to a wider group.
- Work with others in your congregation to bring these concerns before your entire congregation or community.
- Volunteer as a tutor or mentor for children or teens.
- Contribute to organizations that advocate for people who are hungry or poor.
- Write letters of advocacy to your legislative officials at the local, state, and federal levels.
- Organize a delegation to visit with your elected officials.
- Work with persons from other religious groups who have completed this study to move to action.
