In August, the Trump Administration released a draft public charge rule that would penalize legal immigrants who have used public benefits. If implemented, millions of legal immigrant families would never be able to adjust their status (receive a green card, for example). The release of this proposed rule has already meant a de facto cut in assistance.

Bread submitted a comment in opposition to the proposed rule and worked with our partners to encourage as many people as possible to submit comments. We hosted a September webinar for faith communities. Bread partnered in October with the Christian Community Development

Association to convene a networking session with local leaders to learn how the rule is impacting their communities.

Jobs. Bread for the World endorsed the Raise the Wage Act and urged its passage in the House. This bill would gradually increase the federal minimum wage to \$15 an hour by 2024. Raising the minimum wage to \$15 an hour would lift wages for 41 million workers and would lift 1.2 million households out of food insecurity.

Tax credits. Bread continues to support the expansion of tax credits for working families and endorsed The Working Families Tax Relief Act (S. 1138). The bill would expand the EITC to workers not raising children, make the Child Tax Credit fully refundable and create a new Young Child Tax Credit. The bill would increase the income of 46 million households, 114 million people, and 43 million children.
