Bread for the World Institute contributed to research and thought leadership through briefings, coalition meetings, webinars, blogs, and policy papers on a variety of hunger-related policy and programs that came through Congress, including foreign assistance, international climate finance, summer meals, emergency aid for Ukraine, the Global Malnutrition Prevention and Treatment Act, the Global Food Security Reauthorization Act, the Food Donation Improvement Act, International Development Assistance, Food for Peace, McGovern-Dole International Food for Education and Child Nutrition Program, the Healthy Meals, Healthy Kids Act, and the White House's National Strategy, which came out of the White House Conference on Hunger, Nutrition, and Health.
