



Directions to Campus

Driving: Use **Google Maps** or **Waze** to navigate your way to, and around, campus. If using Google Maps, input "McMahon Parking CUA." If using Waze, input "CUA McMahon Parking Lot."

**Apple Maps does not generally provide accurate directions to campus.*

Rideshare Apps

Uber and Lyft both service the campus community, and you can input the **McMahon Parking Lot** to be dropped off and picked up. Drivers and Rideshare app users who are dropped off at the McMahon Parking Lot will be directed to the east side of the guest parking lot in the front of the Pryzbyla Center, the glass building pictured above.



Metro: The Catholic University of America has a dedicated Metro Stop, Brookland/CUA. It is on the Metro's Red Line and is approximately a five-minute walk across campus to the Pryzbyla Center. Please note that the walk from the Metro is uphill.



Parking: Guests may purchase a parking pass by visiting our website at **myparking.catholic.edu**. The Flowbird app may be used for shorter stays. Guest parking is available in the following lots: McMahon, O'Boyle, and Opus. Please note that you will use the above ground guest parking unless you have previously arranged to have garage access.



Shuttle: All students, faculty, staff, and campus visitors are welcome to use the campus shuttle to navigate campus. ADA-accessible shuttles are available upon request.

Check-in Instructions

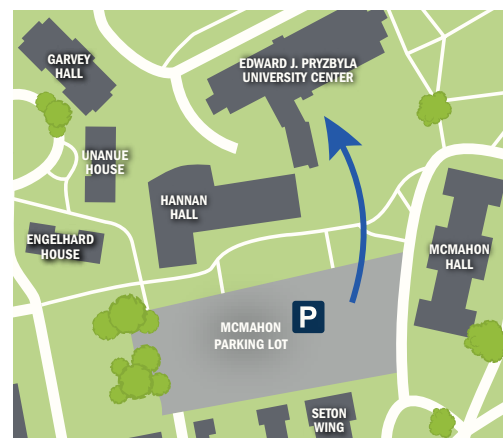
Check-in is at 4 p.m.
